Samuel Seligman, Former Winnipegger, Passes In Vancouver

Word has been received of the passing on Saturday, Feb. 7, of Samuel Seligman, former Winnipegger, resident in Victoria since 1945. He was 65 at the time of his death. Burial took place Monday, Feb. 9, in Vancouver.

The deceased came as a youth from Stchedrin, Russia, to Winnipeg, where he engaged in the wholesale fish business. He moved to Victoria in 1945.
